(2019-2020) 101 CLUB MEMBERSHIP RULES AGREEMENT

1. To be eligible for membership you must be in good sober/clean standing in a recovery program or a service volunteer to the "WFC" recovery service community. You must be recommended for membership by a current 101 Club Member and Membership will be voted on by the current Board of Directors of the Wichita Fellowship Club, Inc.
2. At any one time a member of the 101 Club is allowed to bring his immediate family and two (2) guests. A member, his family & two (2) guests are welcome to the facilities, but children and guests must be accompanied and supervised by the Club Member at all times. Under rare circumstances, and only with the Club Manager's permission, additional guests will be allowed.
3. Safety of all members and guests are of paramount importance. Children are playing in the area.
 - i. No motorized watercraft is allowed in the lake.
 - ii. No motorized recreational vehicles are allowed on the club roads including but not limited to 3 wheel and 4 wheel All Terrain Vehicles, Off-Road Motorcycles, Go Carts, Mini-bikes, golf carts, etc.
 - iii. Speed Limit on club road is 5 miles per hour.
 - iv. Pets are not allowed at the club due to insurance limitations.
 - v. All persons, in and around the pool area, must refrain from running, scuffling, throwing of people in the pools, or any other conduct, which could possibly cause injury. Safety of our swimmers and guests are of utmost importance.
 - vi. No children are allowed in the pools without a parent or responsible adult in the pool area with them.
 - vii. There is NO Lifeguard at the pools; Swim at your own risk. We encourage the "buddy system" when swimming. No swimming late at night after the facilities are closed without the expressed permission of the club manager.
 - viii. No Swimming is allowed in the lake.
4. All Club Members are required to register with the Club Manager when using the club facilities. Campers must register.
5. All Club Members & guests must respect the need for quiet during a 12 Step meeting. Any child or guest of the Club Member may use the facilities during meeting time, but must be supervised by an adult. Entry to Restrooms must be from an outside door.
6. All swimmers must use the outside food-ordering window and use the outside entrance for the restrooms. Wet swimmers are not allowed inside the building.
7. A limit of three fish is allowed per fisherman per day. Fish weighing less than 2 pounds should be returned to the lake. Please do not use live minnows as fish bait.
8. Camping vehicles will be welcome from Memorial Day weekend to Labor Day weekend. All Camping Vehicles must check in with the 101 Club manager. The 101 Club manager must approve the parking spot of each Camping Vehicles. Camping Vehicles are only allowed when occupied. Should you desire to park your Camping Vehicles on the Club premises when not in use, the Club Manager will assign this storage area. There will be a fee of \$50 per month, paid in advance, for storage of your Camping Vehicle when not in use. Unclaimed vehicles will be removed according to legal guidelines. The Club will not be responsible for the safety of your Camping Vehicles.
9. The 101 Club does not at this time have electrical or any other service hook-ups for camping vehicles. We apologize for any inconvenience however we have not had funds to install this amenity.
10. Club Manager can exercise a temporary suspension of Club Membership at his/her discretion. The Club Manager can lift this temporary suspension if the offending Club Member and his/her Membership Sponsor talk with the Club Manager and convince the Club Manager that the offensive behavior will cease. If resolution cannot be satisfied by this means and the Member still desires reinstatement he/she may make application to the WFC Board of Directors for a hearing. Such hearing for reinstatement or permanent suspension will be considered by the WFC Board of Directors at the next meeting of Board of Directors. Any request for reinstatement must be petitioned by the offending Club Member, the Club Member's Membership Sponsor and the Offending Club Member's AA Sponsor.
11. From time to time, new and revised rules will be issued to club members and they will be expected to adhere to rules as if they were first distributed with the membership application and card.
12. **ABSOLUTELY NO DRINKING NOR DRUGS WILL BE ALLOWED. ALL MEMBERS WILL BE EXPECTED TO BE RESPONSIBLE. ALL MEMBERS WILL BE EXPECTED TO BE ATTEMPTING TO LIVE BY THE SUGGESTIONS OF THE 12 STEP PROGRAM.**
